Permit Application
Tank Removal

Above and Underground Storage Tank Removal Application

AGST and UGST removal work must be completed in accordance with the appropriate NFPA Standards, Pennsylvania UCC, Abington Township Adopted Ordinances, and the requirements of the PA DEP Storage Tank Regulations.

The installation or removal of tanks shall be by a recognized contractor who is an experienced specialist in removal of either underground or above ground storage tanks.

ABGST and UGST Permit* application must include all of the following documents:

	Plot plan showing location of tank and associated piping
	Copy of the contractors PA DEP Certification
	PA One Call notification prior to start of the project
	Permit application form must be completed and submitted as part of the plan package
	Copy of Workers Compensation Insurance Coverage Information Form
	Certification of insurance must be submitted with Abington Township as the Certificate holder.
	Copy of executed work contract, providing cost and scope of work. <i>Cost of work must be separate from any other work contracted.</i>
	Permit Fee in accordance with the attached fee schedule + \$4.50 State Fee

- Installation** System installations must be permitted through the Abington Township Code Department. Please call (267-536-1010) or visit AbingtonPA.gov.
- Fee** All required fees including the \$4.50 State Mandate must be paid at time of submittal. Fee Schedule included on page 4.
- Submittal** All required documentation and materials must be submitted as a complete package.
- Inspection** The Fire Marshal must be contacted to perform all required inspections as outlined by relevant codes and as noted in issued permit during installation of the system. Minimum of 48 hours' notice required to schedule inspections.
- Completion** Upon completion of the removal a Closure Report must be submitted to the Office of the Fire Marshal in a timely fashion

STATE MANDATE FEE FOR ALL PERMITS IS \$4.50 effective October 30, 2017

Permit Fee Example:

Removing two (2) 500 gallon tanks (275-1000 gallon tanks are \$50 each)	\$100
Additional State Mandate Fee for all permits	\$4.50
Total Permit Fee Due when permit is submitted	\$104.50

If work within the scope of this permit is commenced prior to the permit being issued, additional fees/penalties may be applied, as well as additional actions taken to protect the safety of Abington Township.
