Information meeting planned - Rita informed all that Commissioner Zappone reported that there is a public meeting to update the public on the Edgehill Tyson project on Nov 14th. Rita and Tim likely to attend.

Spotted Lanternfly alert- recommendations

Rita reported that there have been increased inquiries regarding spotted lantern fly. Rita added information on the STC website. It was noted that Ailanthus is a preferred host. Some discussion around looking at the potential of this invasive tree and controlling it.

PROJECTS

CSX Tree Giveaway - recap

Rita brought our attention to the report drafted as required to closeout the CSX tree giveaway project. The report highlights the tremendous success achieved as well as various learning points, inventory and expense details. Over 190 trees were distributed and planted in the township. 23 different native species were included. Still to complete are the impact stories - We will contact several recipients to interview for their impression on how this tree planting process was experienced by them.

There was a discussion re: various ideas for how to have the most impact with the STC outreach- it was noted that our greatest impact happens when partnering with churches, private schools and other entities with large green spaces.
