FINANCIAL

- 1. Update- balances- no changes since February meeting
- 2. Funds received and deposited- Tree Vitalize Tree Vitalize Forestry Management Grant TV2018/CFM-05 now closed out
- 3. Pending grant- TV Watershed 2019- \$3244 grant with \$4766 match for project total of \$8010 for restoration of riparian area in Hallowell Park- expect funding decision by the end of March
- 4. Pending memorial donation- memorial bench plus budget for plantings at Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- *Andy and Rita following up at the end of March*
- 5. Potential for funds to support tree giveaway at Abington Manor (similar to CSX 2017 event)- no update, awaiting news of fund availability

- 1. **Main topic of discussion:** Arbor Day- rough out plans and procurement for April 27, 2019, 10 am to noon at North Hills Park.
 - a. Colin and Andy will visit and site 1-3 trees. PR and Community involvement underway.
- 2. Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- C2P2 project contractor to begin in April (Andy)
- 3. Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- EHT field consult regarding addition tree removal completed (Collin)
- 4. Memorial Island- Progress is on-going.
 - a. Fundraising in full swing with several opportunities to give. Facebook, Go Fund Me and "Beef & Beer" scheduled in May.
- 5. ASD request- tree-planting program for native shade trees on the campus of Abington Junior High School, in partnership with the Science Department
 - a. site walk -Target Date April 5th
- 6. Landscape ordinance- coordinate review with SALDO Project (Rita)
