#### **WELCOME AND REVIEW AGENDA**

#### FINANCIAL

- 1. Update- balances- Arbor Day expenses
  - a. No significant change or report on finance
  - b. The trees have been ordered for Arbor Day
  - c. Roychester park oak tree will be replaced
- 2. 2019 Grants- TV Watershed UPDATE: Hallowell project was not selected for funding- discuss options;
  - a. Abington was one of many applicants
- 3. Memorial donation- park bench plus trees at Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- to be coordinated with C2P2 restoration project
- 4. Fall tree giveaway- no funds identified

#### **ADVISORY**

- 1. Land Development Application LD-19-01: Proposed existing building revisions and parking lot at the Southeast Corner of Highland and Kenmore Ave- *field assessment completed in March (Carl); recommendations forwarded to the applicant, Planning Commission, Administration & Code Committee and the Board of Commissioners.* 
  - a. no update / continue on a watch mode
- 2. Street Tree master plan for TC street trees- proposal: apply for 2020 Tree Vitalize Forestry Management Grant to refresh 2014 street tree inventory, and to detail a maintenance plan, in partnership with the Public Works staff letter of intent due May 1; discussion: New benchmark-Lakewood Ohio
  - a. Rita proposed the idea of applying for a grant to work on the street tree inventory. Rita spoke about a community in Ohio that has an accomplished street tree maintenance program. A discussion continued about what a maintenance program might look like for Abington and how that it could be handled. Possibly using i-Tree or other electronic method to track.
  - b. Discussion on who would do the tree work, how might the work be funded
  - c. Possibly start small and plan in the growth. Including more trees and areas year over year. Establish a standard.
  - d. All agreed to submit a letter of intent to pursue
- 3. Planning- benchmark Lakewood OHIO master plan; update on Township projects
  - a. Discussed the outline shared regarding the Lakewood program. How can we move toward this. what are next steps, etc.

## **ACTIVE PROJECTS**

- 1. Inventory and Tree Tending- update (Collin and Rita)
  - a. Collin visited and prepared a list of status of trees, observations, recommendations
  - b. Collin reviewed the list and we discussed maintenance needs
  - c. Discussed a program to edge and mulch
  - d. Rita reported that she is working with the PHS tree inventory software along with adding the street tree data from several years ago
- 2. Earth Day at Roychester Park coordinated by Commissioner Carswell. (*Andy and Rita*)request to have mulch delivered and STC guidance on tending the newly planted oak trees

- a. Rita reported on an effort to do an ED event and will be assisting with some tree care at Roychester park. Andy to arrange for mulch delivery to the park.
- 3. Arbor Day-complete plans and procurement for April 27, 2019, 10 am to noon
  - a. Dennis Dougherty / North Hills Park is the location
  - b. 3 trees selected: london plane, oak, 10:30 tree selection walk, 11 am rain barrel workshop and state tree forester to visit at 1130 am
  - c. 8:30 am to load up at Grove park
- 4. ASD request- tree-planting program for native shade trees on the campus of Abington Junior High School, in partnership with the Science Department- *site walk April 5- next steps* 
  - a. Rita and Collin met with school district reps to listen and consider STC assistance for their forest /classroom project. Tim has a June deadline
  - b. STC assisting with layout and design, tree selection, consider supporting a tree planting event in the fall
- 5. Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- C2P2 project contractor to begin in April (Andy)
  - a. Andy to follow up with Think Green to verify April start
- 6. Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary- EHT ongoing (Collin and Rita)
  - a. The results so far on the attention to tree care and the sight inspections have gone well. Work is progressing. No planting observed yet. Spring planting
- 7. Memorial Island- *ongoing (Joe)* 
  - a. project moving along 75k raised so far
  - b. soil moving and hardscaping, utility work to start soon
- 8. Fall Bare Root Trees Planting- 2 potential sites: Hallowell riparian and Roslyn Park
  - a. propose activity at these locations in the fall for the bare root tree activity

  - a. annual report ready to go/report to be presented at the May township meeting
- 2. Landscape ordinance- update and next steps (Rita)

  - a. Discussion continues into May meeting
- 4. Delaware River Watershed Restoration Survey- coordinate response with EAC and watershed associations

- 4. Proposal-seek 2020 ISA Arbor Day of Service for Ardsley Burial Park

- Crestmont Park- monitor trees planted 2015-2016- all doing well- add CSX trees spring 2018?
- Deal Park- planted spring 2018; monitor
- Edge Hill Woods-monitor test trees planted fall 2017 with deer fencing land near
  Edgecomb entrance

- Grove Park- Riparian restoration and Tree planting- spring and fall 2017; Tree survey and labeling- winter 2018-2019
- Hallowell Park- monitor bare root and container planted fall 2017; applied for but not selected for 2019 TV Watershed grant to plant riparian area
