- OYR large canopy trees- needs to be contracted safety considerations
- Ardsley Cemetery- sugar maples planted December 2018- ½ survived first year
- Ardsley Community Center- monitor trees planted 2016-2017- checked 6/19
- Crestmont Park- monitor trees planted 2015-2016- all doing well
- Deal Park- planted spring 2018; monitor
- Edge Hill Woods-monitor test trees planted fall 2017 with deer fencing land near
 Edgecomb entrance
- Grove Park- Riparian restoration and Tree planting- spring and fall 2017; Tree survey and labeling pending
- Hallowell Park- monitor bare root and container planted fall 2017; applied for but not selected for 2019 TV Watershed grant to plant riparian area; cleared riparian and planted 15 bare root trees Nov 2019
- North Hills Park- added 3 trees fall 2018- site for 2019 Arbor Day- checked 5/19
- Old York Road street trees- applied for PECO Green Region bonus grant for phase one renewal
- o Parkdale Avenue- limbed up trees planted through PECO grant- 3/19
- Penbryn Park- monitor trees planted fall 2016- checked 5/19. 20 trees added 10/19
- Rockwell Park- planted fall 2018- lost 3 elms and 1 maple; elms replaced with oaks 2019
