### **BOC COMMITTEE MEETINGS ARE CANCELLED TONIGHT 12/1**

#### THIRD LEAF COLLECTION BEGINS 12/20

The yearly fall leaf collection program is running on schedule this year; however, as there is still an abundance of leaves that have not fallen yet, the Public Works Department will be making a third and final sweep of the township beginning on Monday, December 20, 2021. Please see below for the schedule. Leaves must be placed curbside by 7 AM on your scheduled collection day. Once the Public Works crews come through your neighborhood they will not return. Any leaves put to the curb after this last collection will have to be bagged in brown biodegradable bags and placed curbside for pick up on your trash day.


As a reminder, yard debris is now collected year round in brown biodegradable bags on your normal trash day.

- Lock your vehicle and don't leave gifts/packages in view when shopping.

### **Leaving for the Holidays**

- Use timers for lights and radios while you're away.
- Remember to arrange a hold or pick up of mail and newspapers.

#### **After the Holidays**

- Don't advertise expensive toys, electronics, or other gifts received by the boxes left outside, break them down and dispose of them in recycling.
- Add new items to your home inventory. Take photos or video of all items of value in your home and list each item's make, model, serial number and other information.
