INSTALLATION OF NEW STOP SIGNS




Attention Motorists!

JENKINTOWN ROAD CLOSURE

Jenkintown Road between Meetinghouse Road and Forrest Avenue will be closed weekdays, 9 AM to 3 PM, beginning Monday, January 3, 2022, for water main installation. The road will be closed intermittently over the next five months. Water mains will also be replaced on Fisher Road, Holmecrest Road and Cypress Avenue. Anticipated completion of this project is May 30, 2022. The work will be performed by AQUA Pennsylvania.



WINTER WEATHER TIPS

With the winter months arriving, there are several things residents should do to be sure that they are prepared for winter weather:

- 1. Register for emergency alerts from Abington Township and Montgomery County at <u>www.readymontco.org</u>.
- 2. Be sure to have working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in your home.
- 3. If you use a fireplace to warm your home, be sure to dispose of the ashes in a metal trashcan (with a lid) stored away from your house.
- 4. When it snows, make sure to shovel the fire hydrant closest to your house.
- 5. If you experience a power outage, report it to PECO at 1-800-841-4141 or online at <u>www.peco.com</u>.
