

LIMEKILN PIKE BRIDGE CLOSED 2/5 - 2/6

Limekiln Pike Bridge will be closed in both directions between Willow Grove Ave. and Mount Carmel Ave. beginning 3 PM Saturday, February 5, 2022, through 8 AM Sunday, February 6, 2022, for removal of the Aqua Water Bridge. SUSQUEHANNA ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Utility work is being conducted on Susquehanna Road from Fitzwatertown Road to Bradfield Road and is expected to occur through July 2022.

PECO trench restoration is expected to be complete by late January 2022 with the project being finalized by mid-

February. In March 2022, AQUA America will be replacing the water main along the same section of road. This work is expected to last four to five months. Once complete, the road will be milled and paved.




