3. After completion of the draft plan, additional public outreach and comment will be undertaken. In fact, additional outreach will likely occur prior to the plan's adoption, with details to be determined. When the plan is ready to be considered for adoption, the timeline and procedural requirement for adoption of comprehensive plans specified by the Municipalities Planning Code (PA Act 247), including but not limited to review and approval by the Abington Planning Commission, a formal request for comments from the school district and surrounding municipalities, and the holding of a public hearing by the Board of Commissioners, will occur.
