In January 2015, The Board of Commissioners approved a one-year Per Diem contract extension for the calendar year 2015.

2016 – 2 ½ %

2017 – 2 ¼ %

2018 – 2 ½ %

2019 – 2 ¼ %

Contract provides for a re-opener in 2017 to review alternative health plans to minimize the impact of the Cadillac Tax under the Affordable Care Act.
