REQUIREMENTS:

- The Stormwater Management System (SWM) system (seepage pit, drywell or rain garden) must be installed before the project is completed.
- A soil erosion control plan is required for ALL SWM permit applications. Soil erosion control must be established and maintained during all earth-moving activities.
- Sump pumps may not be discharged into the SWM system.
- It is the responsibility of the homeowner for the upkeep of all SWM systems on their property. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Weekly weeding and watering (Rain Garden).
 - Annual mulching, pruning and replanting (Rain Garden).
 - Sediment removal after large storm events and during extreme weather.
 - Inspection of SWM system after large storm events and weather extremes for blockages from downspouts and cleanout; clearing all debris, as necessary.
 - Replace piping and stone when system is overflowing frequently.
- The applicant must contact the Engineering Department at 267-536-1018 or SMarlin@AbingtonPA.Gov for inspection of the SWM system. The inspector must have 24 hours advance notice for the inspection and must be able to examine an empty pit (Seepage Pit / Dry Well).
