GENERAL FUND:

Motion to adopt a balanced Preliminary General Fund Revenue and Expense Budget for calendar year 2017 of \$38,026,723.

SEWER OPERATING FUND:

Motion to adopt a balanced Preliminary Sewer Operating Fund Revenue and Expense Budget for calendar year 2017 of \$8,844,000.

The proposed budget for the Sewer Operating Fund does include a rate increase in sewer rent charges over the 2016 calendar year, estimated at \$12.00 per household.

HIGHWAY AID FUND:

Motion to adopt a Preliminary Budget for Highway Aid Fund for the calendar year 2017 in the amount of \$1,534,178.

These funds are provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and require no additional funding from Township sources.

RETIREE HEALTHCARE FUND:

Motion to adopt a balanced Preliminary Retiree Healthcare Fund Budget for calendar year 2017 in the amount of \$1,397,290.

Monies supporting this fund are contingent upon the passage of the General Fund, Sewer Fund and Refuse Fund budgets. Budget includes \$200,000 in additional revenues to partially fund OPEB obligations.

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

FUND:

Motion to adopt a Preliminary Tuition Reimbursement Budget for calendar year 2017 in the amount of \$15,000 for Expense Budget and \$5,000 in Revenue. Difference of \$10,000 is funded by principal cash.

WORKERS' COMPENSATION

FUND:

Motion to adopt a balanced Preliminary Workers' Compensation Budget for calendar year 2017 of \$1,007,280.

The difference between revenues and expenses (\$280,280) will be funded from Reserves. Monies supporting the Workers' Compensation Fund are contingent upon passage of the General Fund, Sewer Fund and Refuse Fund budgets.

REFUSE FUND:

Motion to adopt a balanced Preliminary Refuse Fund Revenue and Expense Budget for calendar year 2017 of \$5,782,381.

The proposed budget includes no rate increase on residential refuse fees as defined in Chapter 92 of the Code of the Township of Abington.
