Ordinance No. 2133

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2029, KNOWN AS THE ABINGTON TOWNSHIP HUMAN RELATIONS ORDINANCE. AND SPECIFICALLY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION BY EXPANDING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS FROM FIVE (5) TO SEVEN (7).

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Abington does hereby **Enact** and **Ordain** as follows:

<u>Section 1. Establishment of Human Relations Commission</u>. Chapter 99 titled Human Relations of the Code of the Township of Abington shall be amended by revising the language of subsection 99-6(B) to be and read as follows:

99-6(B) – The Abington Township Human Relations Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall be appointed to terms of three years by the Board. The terms of the members of the commission shall be staggered, such that the terms of 1/3 of the members of the commission shall expire each year. All members of the Commission shall be residents or business owners of the Township of Abington and serve without compensation.

<u>Section 2. Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective as of the date of adoption and enactment by the Board of commissioners of Abington Township.
